# Command Management


This guide will help you enable/disable commands and rule permissions.

## Enable/Disable commands

You can manage your commands for every of your bots seperately. To do so simply click on "Manage commands" for the bot you like to take the changes affect.



To enable a command for your bot select the desired command from the dropdown list. Then simply click on "Add command". To delete a command support press the red button with the x.

Please keep in mind that the changes will take affect after you rebooted your bot.


## Not finding the command you looking for?

## Manage permissions for commands

For every command you enable you must manually assign which roles are allowed to use the command. When you dont assign anybody to use a command, no one will be able to use it :)

To manage assignments click on "Permissions". A modal will appear.

player	Administrator
avator	DJ
player	DJ

Then select command and role to enable execution of the command.
